4 Definitions		Add: area means the geographical area comprising of the three local Government areas of Cardinia Shire, the City of Casey, the City of Greater Dandenong; Community member means a Member who is an individual, as distinct to an organisational member; organisational member means a Member which is an organisation as distinct from a community member;
8 Who is eligible to be a member	Remove: Any person who supports the purposes of the Association is eligible for membership.	Replace with: Any organisation or individual who supports the purposes of the Association is eligible for membership.
12 Annual subscription and fee on joining	Remove: At each annual general meeting, the Association must determine— (a) the amount of the annual subscription (if any) for the following financial year; and (b) the date for payment of the annual subscription. (2) The Association may determine that a lower annual subscription is payable by associate members. (3) The Association may determine that any new member who joins after the start of a financial year must, for that financial year, pay a fee equal to— (a) the full annual subscription; or (b) a pro rata annual subscription based on the remaining part of the financial year; or (c) a fixed amount determined from time to time by the Association. (4) The rights of a member (including the right to vote) who has not paid the annual subscription by the due date are suspended until the subscription is paid.	Replace with: Annual subscription fee and fee on joining the Association are both free.

13 General rights of members	Amend: A member is entitled to vote if— (a) the member is a member other than an associate member; and (b) more than 10 business days have passed since he or she became a member of the Association; and (c) the member's membership rights are not suspended for any reason.	Amend to: A member is entitled to vote if— (a) the member is a member other than an associate member; and (b) more than 20 business days have passed since he or she became a member of the Association; and (c) the member's membership rights are not suspended for any reason.
36 Quorum at general meetings	Amend: (2) The quorum for a general meeting is the presence (physically, by proxy or as allowed under rule 35) of 10% of the members entitled to vote.	Amend to: (2) The quorum for a general meeting is the presence (physically, by proxy or as allowed under rule 35) of 5% of the members entitled to vote.
44 Composition of Board	Amend: (e) ordinary members (if any) elected under rule 53.	Amend to: (e) a maximum of eight (8) ordinary members elected under rule 53.
50 Positions to be declared vacant	Amend: (2) The Chairperson of the meeting must declare all positions on the Committee vacant and hold elections for those positions in accordance with rules 51 to 54.	Amend to: (2) The Chairperson of the meeting must declare all vacant and expiring positions on the Committee vacant and hold elections for those positions in accordance with rules 51 to 54. Add: (3) 50% of Committee positions will be declared vacant annually.
55 Term of Office	Remove: (1) Subject to subrule (3) and rule 56, a Committee member holds office until the positions of the Committee are declared vacant at the next annual general meeting.	Add: (1) an elected Board Member who is elected at any annual General Meeting shall hold office for [2] years and be eligible for re-election.
67 Leave of absence		Add: (3) If a Leave of Absence is applied for by a Committee member and subsequently granted by the Committee, the Committee may appoint a proxy for the period of leave. This proxy would hold voting rights on the Committee.
