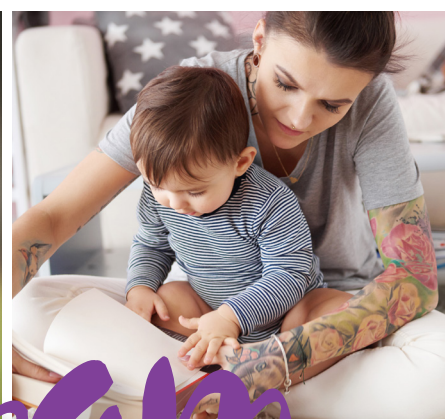

## The Young Parents Education Program enables you to:

- Study with other young parents in a supported and holistic education program.
- Complete Intermediate and/or Senior VCAL with curriculum tailored to your individual interests and needs.
- Obtain direct experience in business and industry through completing a VET qualification, developing the skills and attitudes required in the workplace.

- Increase literacy and numeracy skills.
- Actively participate in incursions and excursions.
- Pathway to an apprenticeship, traineeship, employment or further study.
- Explore parenting and join in early childhood workshops.

YPEP also includes advice and guidance from a range of experts about parenting, early childhood development, financial literacy and counselling, mental health, wellbeing, legal, housing and more.
