Nigel Muller, Executive Manager Training, Auto Apprenticeships & Skills Development Centre, suggests the automotive industry is facing an ever increasing skill shortage across all sectors. Over 27,000 positions across Australia are needed, and this is set to rise to 35,000 positions.
