INTRO

Victoria's recent population growth has been particularly strong. During 2020/2021 there has been an average of 51,400 housing starts each year. By 2020/2025 the forecast is for it to increase to 63,000 with a stronger pace of growth on the high density side of the market. Employment in the construction industry is expected to increase by 1.2% per annum over the decade to 2026-2027, or 33,700 over that period.
