INTRO

Plumbers install, maintain and repair pipes, drains, guttering and metal roofing, mechanical services and related equipment for water supply, gas, drainage, sewerage, heating, cooling and ventilation systems. The number of people working as plumbers (in their main job) stayed about the same over five years, from 79,100 in 2014 to 80,900 in 2019.

Employment opportunities for plumbers has risen strongly in the past five years and will hopefully continue to grow in the long-term. Plumbers are mainly employed in construction; public administration and safety in electrical, gas, water and waste services.
