## INTRO

Victoria is a highly productive region, generating 23 percent of Australia's agricultural output and 30 percent of its food processing by value. Victoria's agricultural industries cover a land area of over 10.6 million hectares. The state's agriculture industry generates over \$13.08 billion in gross value, as of 2016. This is approximately one-quarter of Australia's total gross value of agricultural production. The agriculture industry in Australia includes a number of diverse sub-industries such as sheep, beef cattle and grain farming, fruit and tree nut growing, dairy cattle farming, mushroom and vegetable growing, nursery and floriculture production, other crop growing, poultry farming, deer farming and other livestock farming.
