## INTRO



Cyber security is one of the fastest growing sectors in Australia. The Bureau of Labor and Statistics projects that employment for information security analysts will grow at 32% between 2018 and 2028, which is higher than the average for all other occupations. Australia currently has a shortage of 2300 workers in cyber security, with an expected demand of at least 17,600 additional professionals in the sector by 2026. On 30 June 2020, the Australian Government announced the \$1.35 billion Cyber Enhanced Situational Awareness and Response (CESAR) package.
